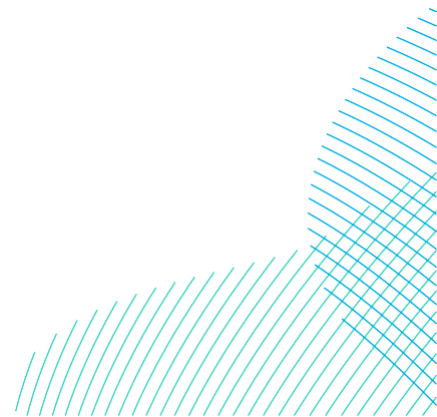

1. Objective

The objective of this policy is to support and encourage active sailing club members. This policy sets out to increase youth, junior and adult participation and development as well as rewarding club volunteers and actively encourage club racing.

The NYC dinghy park is very limited in space and is a shared space with the rowing club and incorporates yacht storage through the winter months. Potential active club sailors are currently being prevented from sailing/joining NYC due to a lack of boat parking space while at the same time the boat park has several unserviceable or unused boats blocking this potential active involvement.

Fees are set for all boats, rebates will be applied on application based on the previous years' contributions and attendance (to the end of September) dependant on scheme applied for.

Only ONE scheme can be used per boat.

e.g. a Brunel Buccaneer cannot keep 7 boats in the yard at £30 each.

Dinghy park fees **INCLUDE** dinghy race fees for the season.

Active racers and boat users will have priority over boats not being used.

*Catamarans may be approved at committee level depending on available space.



Boat Parking Policy

Trailers may be stored under trolleys provided they are not excessively wide.

All trailers and trolleys **must** be kept in serviceable condition to allow movement if required. Failure to do so will result in removal from the yard.

All boats kept in the yard **must** be insured.

2. Standard Dinghy Park Fees

Member Sailing Dinghy	£200 (per year) 1 st April – 31 st March
Member Catamaran Sailing Dinghy*	Un-available
Non-Member Frostbite	£40 (Frostbite Series) 1 st January – 31 st March

3. Junior Scheme

Active under 18 year old members of the Brunel Buccaneers or NYC Race Team who participate in the youth sailing program and have competed in a minimum of 10 club races receive a 85% discount. (Boat fee £30)

4. Youth Scheme

Active 18-24 year olds in full time education who have competed in a minimum of 20 club races receive a 75% discount. (Boat fee £50)

5. Active Racer Scheme

Members who actively support the club by racing 40 races per year (including regattas and all three series (2 races per night)) will receive a 50% discount. (Boat fee £100). This is under 60% of races held by the club. 20 races per year earns a 25% discount. (Boat fee £150).

6. Volunteer Credit Scheme

We value the time and effort that volunteers contribute. Members can earn boat parking fee discounts based on hours contributed. Examples include Race officer, safety boat crew, coaching, maintenance days etc. Contributions must be logged and presented at the end of the season to qualify.

7. Winter Boat Removal Scheme

Members who remove their boats from 1st October – 31st March will be entitled to a 40% reduction.

8. Neyland YC Flying Squad

It is accepted that foiling boats take a certain level of skill and require suitable conditions before racing can take place. Members of NFS (determined by sailing captain) will also receive a 50% discount. (Boat fee £100) provided boats are used an adequate amount likable to the 40 races per year of the active racers.

9. Applying for Discount

1. Complete NYC Boat Park Application Form
2. Select applicable discount scheme and attach supporting documents
3. Submit form by 1st April each year

10. Yacht Fees

Member Yacht	£5 per foot (1 st October – 31 st March)
Member Yacht	Un-available (1 st April – 30 th September)
Member tender	£50 per year (Price pro rata, £50 based on Avon Redcrest)

April – September fee is no longer available due to demand from dinghy racing members following RYA Pathway Club Status. Tenders at discretion of Boat Park Manager. Maximum yachts per winter is 7, first come first served at discretion of Boat Park Manager.

Fine for yachts left past 31st March (depending on crane booking day) – £100 per week.
